

# Fusion Design Software: Supported Operating Systems

## Introduction

As an accredited Microsoft Gold Partner, 20-20 Technologies Ltd operates in full accordance with Microsoft's own policies concerning the support of their operating systems.

In the past, we have undertaken a series of development activities for Fusion which has enabled the software to be awarded Microsoft's 'Certified For Windows Vista™' certification. At the time of writing, we are also in the process of applying for 'Certified For Windows 7™' certification. This demonstrates our continued commitment to deliver quality software capable of functioning on the latest available Microsoft platforms.

Please note that Fusion is not at all supported on non-Microsoft operating systems.

Consistent with Microsoft's own lifecycle policies, customers may well therefore find it necessary to upgrade their operating system prior to the installation of a given version of Fusion.

### “Supported”:

In line with Microsoft's policy on operating system lifecycles, these operating systems can be considered for use as a platform for Fusion.

### “Legacy Support”:

This means that the Fusion software should still run on these operating systems. However, should any issues be identified that are directly attributable to the operating system, 20-20 Technologies Ltd will not provide a solution (in accordance with Microsoft's own practice) and will advise users to upgrade to a more contemporary operating system.

### “Not Supported”:

In line with Microsoft's policy on operating system lifecycles, these operating systems should not be considered for use as a platform for Fusion.
